

CLASSICAL KUFIC


Kufic is a majestic script and the first beautiful script developed for the Arabic alphabet. This stately script isn't fussy and is done with a large nib. Kufic is characterized by its angular form and broad, vertical horizontal strokes. The earliest samples are from large Qurans. This workshop will provide an introduction to the alphabet, followed by a pen and ink demonstration of the earliest simple letterforms and then words. This is a great introduction to the wide world of Arabic script calligraphy. All are welcome!

This workshop requires some specialized tools that will be specified in the materials list.
